**Rules**

- **Entries will only be accepted from residents of Grindleton.**
- The Show Committee reserves the right to refuse any entry that is thought to be contrary to the aims and spirit of the show.
- Entry forms to be in by 5pm Friday 28th August, to Mandy Brennan - telephone 441551.
- Only one entry per person per class will be accepted.
- All entries must be placed in the school hall between 9.00-12.00pm on the day of the show, after which the room will be cleared. No unauthorised person will be allowed in the hall until after the judging.
- The decision of the judges will be final.
- No exhibits to be removed from the hall until after prize giving. Items not removed will be auctioned off with the proceeds going towards Recreation Ground funds.
- Exhibitors are required to provide their own containers.
- Entrants aged 15 and under should give their age on the entry form. Judges will take age into account.
- Rules for each class to be strictly observed.
- All exhibits in classes 1-13 and 18 - 37 must **be grown by the exhibitor.**
- Although every care will be taken the organisers cannot be responsible for the loss or damage to exhibits.
- Prizes to be awarded: 50p, 30p, 15p for 1st 2nd and 3rd. place

Pots or vases not to exceed 10" in diameter. All pot plants should have been grown by the exhibitor or been in his/her possession for at least 6 months prior to the show,

- 4. Vase of Sweet Peas, 6 stems
- 5. Vase of 3 Dahlias
- 6. A spike of Gladioli
- 7. Vase of Calendulas
- 8. Bloom or Spike of Blooms,  
single variety not named above
- 9. 3 stems of perennial blooms  
single variety not named above
- 10. Vase of any mixed garden flowers
- 11. 1 Spike Multi-flowered Rose, any variety
- 12. 1 Specimen Rose with foliage on stem
- 13. Vase of Mixed Annuals

## Floral Art Classes

- 14. Arrangement on the theme "Credit Crunch"  
(size not to exceed 18" x 18")
- 15. Arrangement in style of *Ikebana*
- 16. A floral decoration for the hair
