

Transport costs will be refunded – either petrol costs or a rail warrant will be provided so you don't have to worry about the cost of anything on your Royal British Legion Family Holiday.

### To be eligible for a Family Holiday applicants should meet just one of the following criteria:

- From a household with less than £25,000 gross annual income
- From a one parent household suffering a bereavement or break up of the family
- From a family with one parent currently serving or is to be deployed on overseas operations
- From a family with one parent suffering from mental or physical trauma
- From a family where one parent is caring for a disabled partner
- From a family who have not had a holiday away from home in three years

Family Holidays provide beneficiaries with the opportunity to spend time together as a family, to try new activities and visit new places, or simply to relax at the seaside.
